FREE PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATOR AWARENESS AND TRAINING

You probably know that a Public Access Defibrillator (an AED) has been installed nearby. This is intended to be usable by members of the public in the event of suspected cardiac emergencies. It is automatic, and largely self-explanatory, but the emergency services are concerned that some people may be hesitant to use a defibrillator in a real-life situation.

As the device is close enough for you to obtain and deploy within a practicably short time you, your family, employees, etc., are invited to a **free** two hour Basic Life Support and Defibrillator demonstration and awareness session at Cosy Hall.
